### **Credit Union of Colorado Foundation effort nets \$10,000+ for wildfire relief**

*\$5,000 to Colorado Springs Together; more than \$5,000 to American Red Cross*

COLORADO SPRINGS - The Credit Union of Colorado Foundation has donated \$5,000 to Colorado Springs Together, which is facilitating the rebuilding process for the neighborhoods devastated by the Waldo fire.
