## **Credit Union of Colorado Foundation awards seven scholarships**

DENVER – Seven students at Colorado community colleges have been awarded a total of \$7,500 in scholarships from the Credit Union of Colorado Foundation.

Applicants had to be members of Credit Union of Colorado, be enrolled in one of 13 Colorado community colleges, demonstrate a commitment to community service, and meet qualifications for financial need.
