DENVER- Seven community college students were awarded scholarships totaling \$9,000 from Credit Union of Colorado Foundation and the Foundation for Colorado Community Colleges. The credit union contributed \$7,500, with an additional \$1,500 coming from the Foundation for Colorado Community Colleges.
